Diagnosing Psychotic Disorders: Substance & Psychosis

A diagnosis of Substance Intoxication or Substance Withdrawal should be replaced with a diagnosis of Substance/Medication-Induced Psychotic Disorder only when hallucinations or delusions predominate and when they are severe enough to warrant clinical attention

The Early Diagnosis and Management of Psychosis therefore, need to concentrate on aspects of secondary and tertiary prevention, that is strategies which focus on minimising the impact of these disorders by maximising treatment and rehabilitation efforts Early intervention in first-episode psychosis is one such strategy for secondary prevention

psychosis in early adulthood This condition is further complicated by the high rate of concomitant substance abuse by subjects primarily affected by a psychotic illness which, especially in young patients with an early-phase psychotic disorder, can make the diagnosis very problematic The

DSM-5 Criteria: Major Depressive Disorder

n Presence of specifiers, notably: psychosis, mixed features, suicidality n Presence of cognitive dysfunction (eg, memory complaints; difficulty with concentration, making decisions, and thinking clearly) F Re-evaluate diagnosis if patient has failed to respond to 2 or more treatments F Monoamine oxidase inhibitor (MAOI) augmentation
